Dear President Wesson and Honorable Councilmembers:

The Federation of Hillside and Canyon Associations, Inc., founded in 1952, represents 45 homeowner and resident associations with approximately 250,000 constituents spanning the Santa Monica Mountains. The Hillside Federation considered the original 2015 project proposal at 10101 Angelo View Drive to be the poster child showing an urgent need for the recently enacted updates to the City's Baseline Hillside Ordinance. Modifications to the proposed development are apparently marginally smaller, but do not fundamentally change the Federation's view that the project remains grossly out of scale for its community.

On Tuesday, April 26, Councilmember Koretz moved that the City Council assert jurisdiction to conduct further review of the recent denial of appeals to the Board of Building and Safety Commissioners (CF 17-0348-S1). The Hillside Federation supports the Council's assertion of jurisdiction so that further review of the Board's action can occur.
