The Federation of Hillside and Canyon Associations, Inc., founded in 1952, represents 42 homeowner and resident associations with approximately 250,000 constituents spanning the Santa Monica Mountains. At its meeting of July 18, 2018, the Hillside Federation voted to urge the Board of Public Works to consider requiring the analysis of a polyphagous shot hole borer ("PSHB") expert within the context of an adequate environmental analysis before approving the proposed extensive tree removal at 10768 West Bellagio Road. The project would remove 85 trees, including 22 western sycamores and one coast live oak, in significant part on the basis of alleged PSHB infection.

A hearing in the matter is now scheduled before the Los Angeles Board of Public Works at 10am, Friday, August 31, 2018, in Room 350 of Los Angeles City Hall. Dr. Linda Whitford, a local community advocate informs the Federation's Executive Committee that you are a wellqualified expert whose testimony would greatly assist the Board of Public Works in making a more informed decision on the proposed tree removal.
