Dear Chair Marqueece Harris-Dawson:

The Hillside Federation, founded in 1952, represents 46 resident and homeowner associations with approximately 250,000 constituents spanning the Santa Monica Mountains. The Federation has been closely following the Curtis School expansion project for many years. We have requested reasonable conditions on the project to assure that the project stays within the parameters of its CUP.

The conditions that the community are requesting are not unusual or onerous. Indeed, they are the same conditions that are applied to all the educational institutions in the Mulholland Institutional Corridor:

- 1. No rental of the facility
- 2. No Filming
- 3. On high fire days no construction or special events
- 4. Notice with phone number posted during construction

All conditions belong in the Master Plan CUP document now. To omit them at this time and consider them at a later date as suggested by Planner Tim Fargo is tantamount to piecemealing. There is absolutely no reason why they should not be included in the Master Plan CUP.

Curtis School should not be granted any special privileges that other schools do not have. To do so would establish a very dangerous precedent in this Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone. The Federation urges you to include these conditions in the Curtis School Master Plan now.
