Honorable Mayor Bass:

The Hillside Federation, founded in 1952 and representing 47 resident associations spanning the Santa Monica Mountains, strongly supported Councilmember Yaroslavsky's motion to request that the Planning Director consider rescinding the General Plan Amendment for the Retreat at Benedict Canyon. The Federation's mission is to preserve the integrity of our hard-fought Community Plans. The Planning Director never should have unilaterally amended the General Plan for the hotel. This unwise action is basically a form of spot zoning to evade existing hillside protections and creates a precedent that puts all Community Plans in jeopardy.

Council approved the motion to rescind on August 16. The Federation is now requesting that you encourage Planning Director Bertoni to rescind that amendment.

As CM Yaroslavsky stated so eloquently, the Bulgari Hotel is the wrong project in the wrong place. A hotel does not belong in a residential neighborhood, especially one with steep, narrow, winding streets with only one access. Nor does a hotel belong in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone. The more people you bring into a fire zone, the more likely they are to start a fire. The project has inadequate fire evacuation routes and the surrounding hillside neighborhood has very poor emergency vehicle ingress and egress, which will only be exacerbated by the increased density brought by the hotel. The Sierra Club and the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy are among the environmental groups who oppose the project.

We understand that the construction trades want jobs. We need lots of affordable housing units built. They should focus their efforts where there is the greatest need, not on a luxury hotel.

The Hillside Federation urges you to request the Planning Director to rescind the General Plan Amendment for this hotel project.
