## Re: CF 14-0656 Baseline Mansionization Ordinance Amendment

Dear Councilmembers Huizar, Englander, and Cedillo:

The Federation of Hillside and Canyon Associations, Inc., representing 44 resident and homeowner associations spanning the Santa Monica Mountains, respectfully requests that when PLUM considers amendments to the Baseline Mansionization Ordinance (BMO) (CF 14-0656) tomorrow that you amend the motion to include consideration of amendments to the Baseline Hillside Ordinance (CF 14-1059-S1) at the same time.

These proposed amendments address many of the same issues. The focus of the amendment is to close known loopholes in the Ordinance. It would be much more efficient for the Planning Department to address the loopholes in the Baseline Hillside Ordinance at the same time as the BMO. Both ordinances address the preservation of neighborhoods and the need to maintain the character of communities. While both ordinances have done much to stabilize neighborhoods, closing some loopholes in both ordinances would be very helpful.
