The Federation of Hillside and Canyon Associations, Inc.,<sup>1</sup> respectfully requests your signature on Assembly Bill 25, to allow local regulation of tour buses.

As Los Angeles Councilmember David Ryu (CD 4) has noted, "open air tour buses have been a consistent public safety hazard" and "the levels of traffic and noise caused by . . . unregulated [tour] buses are out of control." Unfortunately, local efforts to better regulate tour buses are hampered by state law. Assembly Bill 25 would significantly enhance the safety of tour bus patrons and local community members, and we join the City Council of Los Angeles in supporting its adoption.
